DURING the last annual communication of the M. W. Grand Lodge of Washington at Seattle, it passed a resolution, on June 12, 1919, authorizing a loan of \$25,000 to the Masonic Temple Association of Bremerton, Washington, for the purpose of assisting in the building of its Masonic Temple. This act was rare in the annals of Masonry and was approved solely by reason of the peculiar situation prevailing in this Navy Yard Community and as a recognition of the active part which it took in the great World War. This enabled the Association to proceed with the construction of the Temple, so long delayed by the Great War, and the corner-stone was laid on July 4, 1919, by the Grand Lodge with Most Worshipful Grand Master Thomas W. Skaggs officiating. It is with the keenest pleasure that we can now occupy the new Temple and invite the Grand Lodge, with its officers unchanged, to dedicate it agreeably to ancient forms and usages.
